## Christ in you - Notes

There is a cost to the proclamation of the gospel. (Paul – Insults, beatings, imprisonment and eventually death.)

Consider some of the potential slips, trips and falls that might occur in a new church.

How does Paul's suffering fill up what is lacking?

What are the tensions likely to exist within the church at Colossae?

Gnostics believed that there were two contrasting principles:

- 1) The spiritual and immaterial which was 'good'
- 2) The flesh and the material world which was 'evil'.

Consider the following statements and consider which ones might be more Gnostic than we might think.

- She is spiritual
- I feel close to God when I am on my own.
- God doesn't want me to engage with the world around me.
- The 10 commandments teach me how to live.

- Toiling for their sake
- Steward in God's household
