How can we follow Paul's instruction and not let anyone disqualify us? In verses 20-23 what are the Colossians adding to Jesus? How might we do something similar? What reasons does Paul give for us not to consider this? What would our Christian lives look like if we took what Paul is saying on board? How would it affect our thinking? Or our attitude?
